WRAL Classes: - AQHA rules are applied with following exceptions:

- Youth -18 may also enter the Beginner, Amateur and Open Division. Youth -18 will earn separate points. Youth may show two-handed in Snafflebit or Hackamore or one-handed on a Bit even senior horses.
- The Beginner division is reserved exclusively for competitors who have not yet entered WRAL-Amateur or WRAL-Open classes. Where no correspondent Beginner class is offered, the competitor may enter the Amateur or Open Division. Once an individual has earned 10 or more points in a performance class he/she will no longer be eligible to participate in Beginner classes in subsequent years. Beginner may show two-handed in Snafflebit or Hackamore or one-handed on a Bit even senior horses.
- In Youth, Amateur and Beginner classes the horse does not need to be owned by the competitor.

AQHA:

- Classes are judged according to AQHA rules.
- Competitors have to send in the required valid membership cards (or must buy it at the show) as well as the horse's registration certificate.

FLSE classes: (just for FLSE licensed riders): AQHA rules are applied with the following exception:

- In Youth and Amateur classes the horse does not need to be owned by the competitor.
- The competitor needs to own an FLSE Western or Competition license; the horse must not be registered.

FLSE Highpoint 2007 Champion: Pleasure, Reining, Trail (open & youth) third Go

- rider needs to have a valid FLSE license,
- The respective WRAL Open Classes count for the calculation of the Highpoint Champion according to the AQHA Point system (AQHA Handbook page 103) A rider with a valid license is automatically participating for the Highpoint calculation, when entering the respective WRAL classes.
